

Bibliography Assignment  
Due Monday Sept. 22

Find 20-30 books or articles on Hume on topics of interest to you.

Focus on work done over the last 5 years, appearing in academic books and journals (so, not textbooks, editions of Hume's writings, encyclopedia articles, web sites of dubious academic merit, etc.).

Bibliographical style is not important, but you should consistently follow some style sheet and should give enough information to allow someone else to find the material you are referencing.

Principal resource for research is the Philosopher's Index. To access it, go to [www.lib.uwo.ca](http://www.lib.uwo.ca)

Fill in the "Off Campus Access" information at top left if you are logging in from off campus.

Click on "Databases by title" (midscreen)

Select P, then Philosopher's Index.

Fill in Hume, set the date range to 2005-09 and, if you only read English, click the "English only" box. Hit "Search"

Have fun. Read abstracts if you are interested in titles. Select what interests you and leave the rest out. Note that not some of what is listed will be only peripherally about Hume and may not be worth including.

Other resources: go back to the library main page and select "Philosophy" under "Browse by program" Then click on databases.

Shelf reading is good. Go to the library and look at what is on the shelves in the section where most of the books on Hume are located (starting around the high B 1400's). Pull down some of the newer books and page through. Look at their bibliographies.
